Rue DIDEROT (the main street running through the town from south to north, lined with shops and restaurants): About 100 metres after the start of the street, look out for the first secret passage on the left, which will lead you directly to the small square on Rue Minot, where you can see a pretty stone well curb

From this marvellous building, you can follow the Halberdiers' Trail, which will take you through the heart of the historic city in the spirit of Lyon's traboules



After passing through a series of small inner courtyards, you'll arrive at Place Ziegler, where you'll need to find the entrance to the longest, bayonet-shaped section of the Halberdiers' Trail, which this time will lead you to the entrance of the Porte des Terreaux – the main gate of the original fortifications.

Following the ramparts, you'll reach the Navarre Tower:
