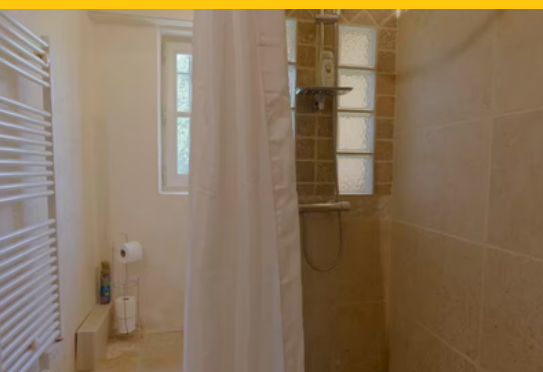

PONT DU GARD AND ESTEZARGUES

Pont du Gard soars above the Gardon, a Roman aqueduct of three perfect stone tiers. A UNESCO masterpiece that turns ancient engineering into timeless art.

Estézargues, 15min away, is a typical southern French village where some of Alice's family members are wine and olive oil makers. You can also find one of her cousins, Hubert, chef at a sustainable Bistro at the heart of the village by the church. Everything is within 5Km radius.

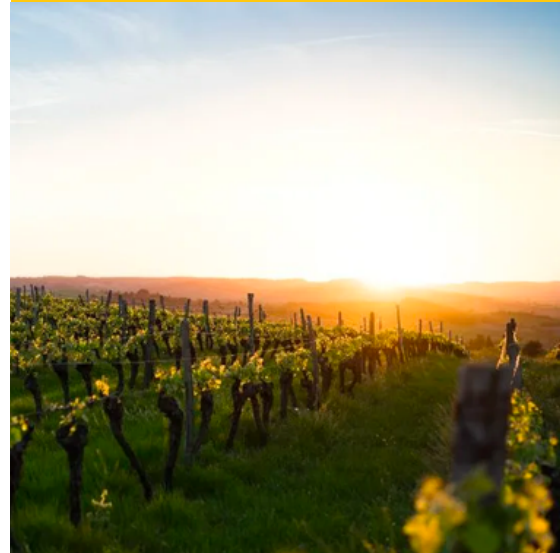
